Place is where I was born, raised and went to elementary (primary) school. It is a six hour journey by road. I would love to have fellowship with my extended family, as well as help my sons bond. That time I will have opportunity to minister to small rural village churches I did plant in the past years. My Associate pastor will minister in Nakuru fellowship when I am away. Hope that you will not leave us out when doing your Christmas plans and budgeting. God bless you and I will endeavor to pray for you more diligently. I will keep on beholding you in the hands of God and committing all your issues, needs and worries to him Jehovah God who is able to do all things. Surely, divine touch and power of the anointing for greatness and victory follow you forever. May peace, good health, divine healing, provision and favor shall be your portion.
